1.4.1 Feedback of Stake Holders 2021-22

The feedback of the stakeholders is conducted and collected by the college IQAC.

1. Student feedback on Teachers

Analysis of the Student feedback on Teachers for the academic year 2021-2022.

The Student evaluation of teachers is collected every year confidentially. The assessment is based on the following 10 parameters as mentioned below:

- 1. Capability of the teacher to make the subject understand.
- 2. Completes the prescribed syllabus as per the time table and term.
- 3. Begins and ends each class on time.
- 4. Communication, logical presentation and ICT usage by the teacher
- 5. Integrates course material with reality and provides a broader perspective.
- 6. Teacher clarifies doubts / questions raised by the students.
- 7. Teacher is prompt and fair in Internal Assessment.
- 8. Treats the students with respect and deals with their problems in a friendly way.
- 9. The teacher is available beyond the class hours.
- 10. Sincerity and commitment of teacher towards her / his profession.

Student feedback is obtained from each class through Google forms, the form that consists of multiple choices viz., Outstanding, Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory options. Students were given as many forms as the number of teachers who taught him/her during the Course. IQAC collected the feedback and analyzed the same.

The 'Outstanding' option is assigned 4 points; 'Good' 3 points; 'Satisfactory' 2 points and 'Unsatisfactory' 1 point, and an average for the teacher and the departments of all the students' ratings are calculated. A brief picture of the student feedback for the year 2021-22 is as follows:

For the College as a whole the students have assigned 3.16 points out of 4 to their teachers, which is a good record. Individually most of the teachers are rated between 3 and 4 and few of the teachers are rated between 2 and 3.

Action Taken

The teachers those who have obtained less points were informed to improve and fulfill the expectations and needs of the students in the coming academic years.

2. Feedback on Curriculum Evaluation by Teachers

Analysis of the Curriculum Evaluation by Teachers for the academic year 2021-2022 The Curriculum Evaluation by teachers was obtained through online mode both for odd and even semester. The assessment is based on the following 10 parameters as mentioned below:

- 1. Are the aims and the objectives of the syllabi well defined and clear to the teachers and students?
- 2. Is the depth of the course content adequate to have significant learning outcomes?
- 3. Is the syllabus suitable to the course?
- 4. The timely coverage of syllabus is possible in the mentioned numbers of hours?
- 5. Are the units/sections in the syllabus properly sequenced?
- 6. Is the course content followed by corresponding reference books/materials?
- 7. The programme and curriculum is enriched as compared to similar programme offered by other universities?
- 8. Syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry/ current global scenarios and academics?
- 9. Does the course/programme of studies carry sufficient number of optional papers?
- 10. Are the books listed as reference material relevant and appropriate?

Each parameters were given multiple choices i.e Agree, Strongly agree, Disagree and Strongly disagree. The result was analyzed in percentages.

65.3 % of the teachers agree to the point that the aims and the objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to the teachers and students.

- 42.9% of the teachers strongly agree that the depth of the course content is adequate to have significant learning outcomes.
- 46.9% of the teachers strongly agree that the syllabus is suitable for the course and only 2.1% strongly disagree to this.
- 59.2% agree that the timely coverage of syllabus is possible in the mentioned number of hours
- 38.8% of the teachers strongly agree that the sections in the syllabus is properly sequenced and 4.1% disagree to that.
- 59.2% of the teachers agree that the course content is followed by corresponding reference books and 5.1% disagree to that.
- 28.6% of the teachers strongly agree that the programme and curriculum is enriched as compared to similar programme offered by other universities and 67.3% agree to that.
- 63.3% of the teachers agree that the syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry standards /current global scenarios and academics and 30.6% strongly agree to that.
- 32.7% of the teachers strongly agree that the courses carry sufficient number of optional papers and 61.2% agree to this.
- 67.3% of the teachers agree that the books listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and appropriate.

3. Feedback by Alumni

Analysis of Alumni feedback for the academic year 2021-2022.

The Alumni feedback was obtained through online. The assessment is based on the following 12 parameters as mentioned below:

- 1. How do you rate the admission procedure?
- 2. How do you rate the skill orientation of the courses you learnt?
- 3. How do you rate the faculty?
- 4. How do you rate the hostel facilities?
- 5. How do you rate the canteen facilities?
- 6. How do you rate the health facilities?
- 7. How do you rate the infrastructure and lab facilities?

- 8. How do you rate the library resources?
- 9. How do you rate the learning experiences?
- 10. How do you rate the relevance of the course studied to the real life?
- 11. How do you rate the content learnt in relation to your current job?
- 12. How do you rate the industry/field/library/lab visits?

Each parameters were given multiple choices i.e, Excellent, Very Good, Good, Fair and Poor. The result was analyzed in percentages: 65.7 % of the alumni have excellent opinion about the library resources, 37.1 % have a very good opinion about the hostel facilities, infrastructure and lab facilities and about the content learnt in relation to their current job also 37.1 % have good opinion about the health facilities whereas 14.3 % of them have fair opinion about the health facilities and also 20% of them feel very poor opinion about the canteen facilities. Finally the overall feedback on admission procedure is rated as excellent by 55.4% of the alumni.
