



Whereas KUD is the second oldest University in the state of Karnataka after the Mysore University. Established initially at Mumbai in 1949, the location was shifted to Dharwad in October, 1949. (The Bombay Legislature of the erstwhile Bombay Presidency established Karnatak University through the Karnatak University Act 1949. It became a statutory University on 1st March 1950.)
