

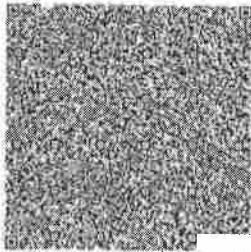

Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding (hereafter referred to as 'MOU' signed on the ----- day of ----- 2017 at Amarkantak by & between Indira Gandhi National Tribal University (IGNTU) at Amarkantak, Madhya Pradesh, India (hereafter referred to as IGNTU).

AND

Karnatak University (KUD) at Dharwad, Karnataka (hereafter referred to as KUD)

Whereas Indira Gandhi National Tribal University (IGNTU) was established by an act of Parliament in 2007 with day of ----- 2017 at Amarkantak by & between Indira Gandhi National Tribal University (IGNTU) at Amarkantak, Madhya Pradesh, India (hereafter referred to as IGNTU).

and objectives:

- To provide avenues primarily for the tribal population of India
- To disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in tribal art, tradition, culture, language, medicinal systems, customs, forest based economic activities, flora, fauna and advancement in technologies relating to the natural resources of the tribal areas.
- To collaborate with national and international universities and organisations, especially for undertaking cultural studies and research on tribal communities
- To formulate tribal centric development models, publish reports and monographs and to organise conferences and seminars on issues relating to tribal communities and to provide inputs to policy matters in different spheres
- To take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching learning process in the areas of their interest including Tourism and Hospitality industry.

In view of the aims and objectives of the University the major thrust shall be on providing better opportunities to students of all sections of society for pursuing interdisciplinary research.

Whereas KUD is the second oldest University in the state of Karnataka after the Mysore University. Established initially at Mumbai in 1949, the location was shifted to Dharwad in October, 1949. (The Bombay Legislature of the erstwhile Bombay Presidency established Karnatak University through the Karnatak University Act 1949. It became a statutory University on 1st March 1950.)

The following are the aims and objectives of KUD:

- To collaborate with IGNTU

- To formulate tribal centric development models, publish reports and monographs and to organise conferences and seminars on issues relating to tribal communities and to provide inputs to policy matters in different spheres
- To take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching learning process in the areas of their interest including Tourism and Hospitality industry.

3. Conferences and Seminars

As part of this collaboration, National Level Conferences and Seminars may be promote and contribute towards inclusive policies to ensure equal rights, opportunities and entitlements for all sections of society.

The Parties hereby agree that:

- a) Both the Universities shall work towards strengthening capacities of amrginalised groups. One such way shall be through offering M.Phil./Ph.D programme under the collaborative scheme betweenAs part of this collaboration, National Level Conferences and Seminars m programme shall be awarded bromote and contribute towards inclusive policies to ensure equal rights, opportu per the guidelines issued by thand entitlements for all sections of society. of Ph.D degree) and IGNTU from time to time at IGNTU
- b) The title of the programme shall be M.Phil./Ph.D Programme
- c) There shall be a Joint Coordination Committee (hereafter referred to as JCC) constituted of representative from IGNTU and KUD. The JCC shall be constituted of two members from each and stand to D members – two members fromhrough the collaborative efforts for pursuing programmes in the areas ment DTS the Chairperson of the Coierein above. oversee the activities of the programme in accordance with the statutory framework of IGNTU and KUD. The JCC shall meet twice in a year to monitor and review the mechanisms of the programme.
- d) The Board of Studies (BoS) shall be constituted. The Bos snai comprise of seven members in which KUD shall nominate four members; and IGNTU shall nominate three members. In addition, KUD shall co-opt one member (expert) from outside the university system. Preferably as practitioner of a hospitality industry. The Chairpersons of the BoS shall be from KUD and Co-Chairperson form IGNTU.
- e) The meetings of Board of Studies shall decide on the academic programme when to be convened periodically, at least once in six months

- i) Library and laboratory facilities of IGNTU and KUD shall be availed by the students and scholars of both the institutions.
- j) The travelling allowances and honorarium shall be borne by IGNTU. However, local hospitality of the nominated members of the IGNTU for attending the JCC/BoS meeting or any other academic meeting at IIDS shall be borne by KUD. Same is true for the KUD members while travelling depending upon the location of the meeting.

k) The MoU shall remain valid for a period of five years and may be renewed further on terms and conditions mutually agreed by Parties in writing.

l) This MoU shall be terminated by either party on an advance notice of six months. However, if this MoU is terminated for whatsoever reason, the responsibilities of each Party shall continue to exist till the completion of the programmes already agreed upon.

j) The MoU shall remain valid for a period of five years and may be renewed further on terms and conditions mutually agreed by Parties in writing.




