

### **1.4.1 Feedback of Stake Holders**

The feedback of the stakeholders is conducted and collected by the college IQAC.

#### **1. Student feedback on Teachers**

Analysis of the Student feedback on Teachers for the academic year 2020-2021

The Student evaluation of teachers is collected every year confidentially. The assessment is based on the following 10 parameters as mentioned below:

1. Capability of the teacher to make the subject understand.
2. Completes the prescribed syllabus as per the time table and term.
3. Begins and ends each class on time.
4. Communication, logical presentation and ICT usage by the teacher
5. Integrates course material with reality and provides a broader perspective.
6. Teacher clarifies doubts / questions raised by the students.
7. Teacher is prompt and fair in Internal Assessment.
8. Treats the students with respect and deals with their problems in a friendly way.
9. The teacher is available beyond the class hours.
10. Sincerity and commitment of teacher towards her / his profession.

Student feedback is obtained from each class, the form that consists of multiple choices viz., Outstanding, Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory options. Student is given as many forms as the number of teachers who taught him/her during the Course. For enabling the students to answer in a clear, fair and impartial manner, the forms are translated into Kannada. Teachers from other departments are deputed to administer the feedback. IQAC collected the feedback and analyzed the same.

The 'Outstanding' option is assigned 4 points; 'Good' 3 points; 'Satisfactory' 2 points and 'Unsatisfactory' 1.5 points, and an average for the teacher and the departments of all the students' ratings are calculated. A brief picture of the student feedback for the year 2020-21 is as follows:

For the College as a whole the students have assigned 3.93 points out of 4 to their teachers, which is a good record. Individually most of the teachers are rated between 3 and 4 and few of the teachers are rated between 2 and 3.

#### **Action Taken**

The teachers those who have obtained less points were informed to improve and fulfill the expectations and needs of the students in the coming academic years

## **2. Feedback on Curriculum Evaluation by Teachers**

Analysis of the Curriculum Evaluation by Teachers for the academic year 2020-2021

The Curriculum Evaluation by teachers was obtained through online mode both for odd and even semester. The assessment is based on the following 10 parameters as mentioned below:

1. Are the aims and the objectives of the syllabi well defined and clear to the teachers and students?
2. Is the depth of the course content adequate to have significant learning outcomes?
3. Is the syllabus suitable to the course?
4. The timely coverage of syllabus is possible in the mentioned numbers of hours?
5. Are the units/sections in the syllabus properly sequenced?
6. Is the course content followed by corresponding reference books/materials?
7. The programme and curriculum is enriched as compared to similar programme offered by other universities?
8. Syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry/ current global scenarios and academics?
9. Does the course/programme of studies carry sufficient number of optional papers?
10. Are the books listed as reference material relevant and appropriate?

Each parameters were given multiple choices i.e Agree, Strongly agree, Disagree and Strongly disagree. The result was analyzed in percentages: 66.7 % of the teachers agree to the point that the aims and the objectives of the syllabi well defined and clear to the teachers and students, 42.9% of the teachers strongly agree that the course content is followed by corresponding reference books/materials. Among the teachers 9.5% of them disagree that Syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry/ current global scenarios and academics and only 2.5% of them strongly disagree on the same parameter.

### **3. Feedback by Alumni**

Analysis of Alumni feedback for the academic year 2020-2021

The Alumni feedback was obtained through online. The assessment is based on the following 12 parameters as mentioned below:

1. How do you rate the admission procedure?
2. How do you rate the skill orientation of the courses you learnt?
3. How do you rate the faculty?
4. How do you rate the hostel facilities?
5. How do you rate the canteen facilities?
6. How do you rate the health facilities?
7. How do you rate the infrastructure and lab facilities?
8. How do you rate the library resources?
9. How do you rate the learning experiences?
10. How do you rate the relevance of the course studied to the real life?
11. How do you rate the content learnt in relation to your current job?
12. How do you rate the industry/field/library/lab visits?

Each parameters were given multiple choices i.e, Excellent, Very Good, Good, Fair and Poor. The result was analyzed in percentages: 70.4 % of the alumni have excellent opinion about the library resources, 39.8 % have a very good opinion about the admission procedure, 33.5 % have good opinion about the canteen facilities whereas 12.5 % of them have fair opinion about the same parameter. Finally the overall feedback on academic programmes is rated as excellent by 55.4% of the alumni.

## Student Satisfaction Survey 2020-21

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the obligatory criteria set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. From 2017 onwards the NAAC has endeavored to carry out a Student Experience Survey, the results of which will go into the accreditation process. The Survey includes 25 competency based, objective and subjective questions. The responses to which are given anonymously by students of the institution. This survey corresponds to an institution level feedback on curriculum, teaching and learning, infrastructure, administration and library. We implemented SSS on-line through students groups during the month of September 2021 and received on-line response from 162 students which was analyzed by the feedback committee and reported to the head of the institution.

The observations of SSS are as follows:

**Teaching-Learning** - Students appreciated teachers' lectures in terms clarity and understandability and also they had a good opinion on teachers' regularity in engaging the classes. Further they were satisfied that teachers come well prepared for the classes and complete the syllabus in time. It is also noted that students expressed their dissatisfaction regarding teachers not using teaching aids effectively.

**Curriculum** - Students show outstanding opinion regarding the objectives stated for each course as well defined and further opine that the curriculum opportunities to develop abilities and required skills. Students show good opinion about the curriculum as it focuses on goals to be achieved and clearly defines the effectiveness of syllabus, question paper pattern and evaluation. Students express satisfaction regarding curriculum that is supportive towards market requirements/placements/to pursue higher studies. They expressed dissatisfaction that the curriculum does not cater to their needs of preparation for competitive exams.

**Student Satisfaction Survey** - Students show outstanding opinion regarding activities of NCC, NSS and Gymkhana. They express good opinion about effectiveness of the student welfare office/Grievance Redressal cell/ Counseling cell in student support measures. They are satisfied with the canteen facilities – food quality/ambience/support staff. It is to be noted that they are dissatisfied with information regarding the availability of the scholarships.

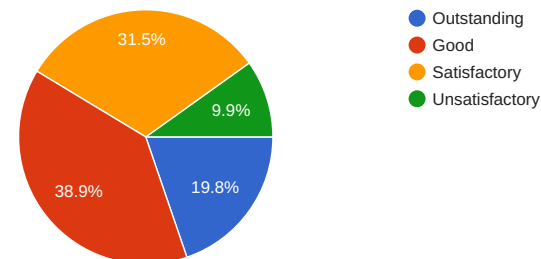
