# ATTRIBUTES FACILITATED BY THE INSTITUTION FOR THE STUDENTS

Apart from the regular college facilities :

- The college Alumni Association arranges for special talks inviting renowned guests and encourages the students to get inspired by them.
- Karnatak Arts College gymkhana provides opportunities to the students to witness to famous artists, literary personalities, educationists, successful entrepreneurs and sports persons by inviting and honouring them.
- Students are honoured with cash prizes and medals during the rank holders felicitation function every year.
- Special care is taken of the students belonging to disadvantaged sections.
- Sports students are given their diet money and are exempted from the tuition fees. Their fees are paid by the teachers.
- The participants at the National Level Sports are given free hostel facilities.
- The college bears the expenses of the students who represent the college in Inter-Collegiate, Inter-District & Inter-State Activities by paying them TA/DA.
